COOK-OFF RULES

1. Teams will be permitted to set up cookers, etc., any time on Friday.
2. Teams will be briefed at 7:00 p.m. Each team must send at least one member of their team to the briefing. Team numbers & cooking area assignment will be issued then. Cooking will begin after the briefing. All hogs must be cooked on site.
3. Each team is responsible for having at least a 100 ft. water hose & 12 gauge extension cord(s) -
4. Judging will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m., Sat., Oct. 17th and winners will be announced approximately 12:00 noon.
5. **ABSOLUTELY NO BBQ WILL BE SOLD OR GIVEN AWAY** to the public until after the judging and the winners are announced. You will be dissatisfied if this happens, and your hog will be taken!!!
6. Aprons must be worn by all team members at the time of judging and cooking areas must be kept clean at all times.
7. After cooking, all meat must be maintained and covered at 130'. Each team will be required to have a meat thermometer on site.
8. The chief cook will be held responsible for the conduct of his/her team & guests. Fighting will not be tolerated! This will mean disqualification.
9. All teams must be discreet with any alcoholic beverage on the premises. Alcoholic beverages must be in cups. Teams are not allowed to give or sell alcoholic beverages to the public.
10. Decorating of your cooking area with streamers, banners, flags, signs, etc. to boast about your team or brag about your superiority in the finer art of "outdoor cooking" is appropriate and encouraged.
11. Each team is responsible for clean-up of their area at the conclusion of the cook-off.
12. If any of the above rules are broken, teams may be disqualified.
13. When leaving Saturday, have a Town staff member help you get out.
14. **ABSOLUTELY NO refrigerators or microwaves.**
15. **NO FUNERAL HOME TENTS ARE ALLOWED; POP UP TENTS ONLY. DO NOT DRILL OR HAMMER ANYTHING INTO THE PAVEMENT.**
16. **THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES IS FINAL!!!**
